Knight Oil Tools' 2013 OSHA Total Recordable Incident Rate (TRIR) was .97, once again, well below the oil and gas industry rate of 1.6. Additionally, Knight Oil Tools recently received its Experience Modifier Rate for 2014. The new rate is .51, which is a drop from .59 for 2013. This extraordinary rate means that the company will pay approximately 50% less for Workers' Comp Insurance in 2014 and signals to our customers and employees that we truly believe in safety.



